Since 2005, The Wilmington Fur Ball has donated over \$342,000 to no-kill animal shelters and animal groups in New Hanover, Pender, and Brunswick counties. Funds are raised through sponsorships, donations, and our annual fundraising event.

This year we were able to support twelve (12) very worthy groups who rescue animals that have been abused, abandoned, or surrendered. They often rescue animals from shelters that might otherwise euthanize them if not adopted. These rescued animals receive medical care (including spay/neutering,) nourishment, training programs, and a caring environment while they wait for their “forever” home.

It is this type of effort that makes our committee’s work so gratifying. But our work continues.
